The most important is that the teachers are helpful, kind, understanding and always ready to answer our questions. Arany is incredibly good at teaching





János Neumann was born in Budapest in 1903, where he studied at the Budapest University of Sciences, later continuing his studies in Berlin, and finally working as a professor in the United States, there he created the world's first computer with memory in 1952. 8. Hosszú Katinka-swimmer



HOSSZÚ KATINKA



Three-time Olympic, nine-time World and 15-time European champion Hungarian swimmer. She is the first swimmer to hold the world record in all five medley swimming events (200 m, 400 m, short course: 100 m, 200 m, 400 m) at the same time. At the Rio Olympics she achieved the greatest success of her life. With 3 gold medals and 1 silver medal, she was the most successful swimmer in individual events at the Olympics.
